Submission Guidelines for Presenters

1. Overview

The Emotional Intelligence Summit invites you to submit poster presentations that showcase your innovative work in emotional intelligence. Your poster should visually communicate your findings, ideas, and solutions, engaging summit attendees in constructive discussions.

2. Submission Categories

Align your submission with one or more of the following categories:

- Emotional Intelligence in Leadership and Workplace Development
- Emotional Intelligence in Education and Youth Development
- Emotional Intelligence and Mental Health
- Cross-Cultural Perspectives in Emotional Intelligence
- Neuroscience and Emotional Intelligence
- EI in Conflict Resolution and Relationship Management
- Technology and Emotional Intelligence (e.g., AI tools, apps)
- Case Studies of EI Interventions and Assessments





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3. Submission Requirements

A. Abstract Submission

- Word Count: 300-500 words
- Format: Microsoft Word or PDF
- Content:
 - Title (concise and reflective of the study)
 - Author(s) name, title, and affiliation(s)
 - Contact information (email and phone number)
 - Category selection (from Section 2)
 - Keywords (up to 5)
 - Objectives and Purpose
 - Methods and Approach
 - Key Findings or Insights
 - Implications for Practice or Research

B. Visual Design Guidelines

- Poster Dimensions: 36 inches x 48 inches (landscape orientation)
- Font Requirements:
 - Title: 72-100 pt
 - Subheadings: 36-48 pt
 - Body Text: 24-30 pt
 - Captions: 18-24 pt
- Design Tips:
 - Use clear, high-resolution visuals (300 dpi minimum)
 - Incorporate a clean, professional design
 - Limit text blocks to maintain readability
 - Use charts, graphs, images, or infographics to enhance understanding
- Colors: Ensure accessible color contrast for readability
- File Format: PDF or JPEG for final printing

C. Submission Portal

- Submit via the official summit submission portal by May 30, 2025.
- An acknowledgment email will be sent upon successful submission.

4. Evaluation Criteria

Your poster will be evaluated by the summit review committee based on:

- Relevance to Emotional Intelligence: Alignment with the summit's themes and contribution to the field.
- Clarity and Organization: Logical flow of information and clear presentation.
- Visual Impact: Effective use of visuals to communicate key points.
- Scientific Assessment: Quality of research design, methodology, and analysis.
- Practical Implications: Application of findings in real-world settings.

5. Presentation Requirements

- Presenter Presence: At least one author must be present during the scheduled poster session to engage with attendees.
- Time Allotment: Prepare to give a 3-5 minute overview and answer questions.
- Display: Posters will be displayed on freestanding boards, with mounting supplies provided.

6. Important Dates

- Submission Deadline: May 30, 2025
- Notification of Acceptance: June 13, 2025
- Final Poster Submission (Digital Copy): June 30, 2025
- Summit Poster Presentation Date: July 11, 2025
